Le Petit Pont Reserve Blanc 2007/8. Vin de Pays d'Oc. France **£12.95**

Great value. Fabulously clean and zesty and ridiculously easy to drink.

Tempus, Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Chile **£13.75**

From the central valle region. This is a wine with all the characteristic gooseberry aromas shown by Sauvignon Blanc grape. Good acidity and very refreshing.

Pinot Grigio 2007/8, Villa Blanca, Hungary, 2008 **£13.95**

Dry and medium bodied it has a citrusy, crisp finish, with a hint of grapes.

Conway Hills, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand **£14.25**

Intensely young and vibrant, full of upfront grassy, nettley and gooseberry flavours.

Marlborough is recognised as the best New World location for Sauvignon and this is a perfect example of its kind. The perfect accompaniment to fish.

Macon-Lugny, Les Genievres, Louise Latour 2006, Burgundy. France **£15.25**

Excellent Chardonnay from the Maconnais, produced in a single village. Ripe and fruity with well balanced acidity and good length of flavour. Bigger and fatter than Macon Superieur Blanc

Pouilly-Fume, 2007, Domaine Jonathon Pabiot, Loire Valley. France **£18.50**

Better value now than Sancerre and every bit as good. A real classic made in tiny quantities.

Le Petit Pont Reserve Rouge 2007, Vin de Pays d'Oc. France **£12.95**

Juicy, medium bodied and fresh, packed with flavours of velvety redcurrants and strawberries.

Tempus Merlot, 2008, Chile **£13.75**

From the Valle Central area of Chile. This wine has aromas of cherries, pepper and cocoa. It's full bodied and goes well with cheese, pasta, risotto, ham and white meats.

Poker Face, Shiraz, Australian **£14.95**

Robust and full bodied red wine

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2007 DOC, Italy **£15.25**

Really fruity, juicy fruit flavours dominate this wine with a super-ripe, near perfect mouth feel.

Valserrano Crianza 2004/5 Bodegas Marquesa, Rioja DOC, Spain **£16.95**

Gorgeously seductive Rioja with smooth dark fruit, a little spice and a long soft finish.
